

## LANCASTRIA.

Returning from the last Mediterranean cruise of the season the liner Lancastria went ashore in a gale near Wallasey. Four hundred and fiftyfour passengers and a crew of three hundred and fifty were on board at the time. As the tide went out the Lancastria was left high and dry, but eight hours later tugs were able to pull her into deep water.

In worse case was the New York Freighter Ohioan, trapped on the treacherous rocks of the Golden Gate ~~near~~ off San Francisco. Ten tounsand citizens came out to line the cliffs and watch the unfolding of a sea drama as the fog lifted. ~~At about 11~~ Coast Guards came to the rescue with a breeches buoy --- ~~taking off the crew of forty-two~~ --- for no ships dared approach the stricken vessel as she lay in her nest of jagged rocks. The ship was doomed, but ~~tragic as that~~ ~~was~~, thanks to the Coast Guards no lives were lost.
