Not the least important preparation for the Coronation is the work being carried out by Garrad's inxhexweek on the crown of her Majesty the Queen. Her the mailar work being lone for the Prince Blacketh and Margaret Bess. / Jewellery, gold and platinum to the value of many thousands of pounds are handled by expert experts with all the loving care of craftsmen --- and the jewels include that wonder gem --- the Koh-i-Nor Diamone. When these final pictures were taken the work was still unfinished --- left to right Princess Margaret Rose's --- Her Main the Queen's and Princess Elizabeth's. Coronation preparations are still going ahead in konaxaz London's great thoroughfares --- day by day the workaday world is being transformed. And now at Great Fosters, let us watch the rehearsal for the pageant of the Coronation Ball, helping to provide a National Theatre. Lady Oxford portrays Good Queen Bess, while wkner mariety others in graceful procession walk through the pages of history. I'm not sufficiently well versed in the classics to know exactly what this is, but I think it is the ancient Greek ceremony of calling for the empties. But if you want to see how coming events cast their shadows before --- the children of Wenlock School gave a performance representing the Coronation.

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
