crowds assmeble in Whitehall. This year a new King attended the ceremony --- King George and Queen Elizabeth were received by the Home Secretary Sir Samuel Hoare, and his under Secretary, Mr Geoffrey Lloyd, on their arrival at Clive Steps.

Thehthe King placed his wreath upon the Centraph Eleven o'clock --- and for two minutes a nation remembered in gratitude those who had laid down their lives. But his year the solemnity of the occasion was disturbed by a man who brokw shouting from the silent crowd. Police officers hustled him away and the service continued Mr Neville Chamberlain, the Prime Minister, next laid a wreath at the Centraph. Completing the ceremony at the Centraph, King George walked down Whitehall to lay another wreath at the foot of the statue of Earl Haig.
