Then the Swordbearer handed over the sword to the outgoing Lord Mayor, who in turn presented it to his successor, the same ceremony following with the Mace. The ceremony is over. Former Lord Mayors, Aldermen, Recorder, Sheriffs and Officers ~~congratulated~~ congratulated the new Chief Magistrate of the City of London. This is the official admission of the new Lord Mayor, preceding the splendour and pageantry of the Lord Mayor's Procession.
