Lined up and ready for action on Salisbury Plain --- the Larkhill School of Gunnery. Eighteen pounders and howitzers in action teach the young gunner how to be a pain in the neck to a target mailes away. The Army's at work.

After that --- the Royal Corps of Signals gave a rehearsal display at Catterick Camp in Korkshire. They will do this sort of thing at the Royal Tournament and at the Empire Exhibition in Glasgow. The Army's at play.

It's crazy riding --- but it's safe when you know how to do it. And when you get safely through a test like this, a war would seem like a rest cure.
