CHAMBERLAIN'S SECOND JOURNEY.

After the consultation with the British Cabinet and with France and the sending of the terms of suggested settlement to the Government of Czechoslovakia, Mr Neville Chamberlain left Meston again for his second meeting with Herr Hitler

that his ultimet Floment with Greekeslevakia. / While Mr Chamberlain was flying to Germany, Herr Mitler was arriving at the Hotel Dreesen where in Godesberg The proprietor of this hotel was a personal friend of the Fuehrer. He knew him when he was a corporal in the Army; and he supported Hitler at a time when he had very few supporters Mr Chamberlain's plane landed at Cologne airport. and the Premier was greeted by Sar Nevile enderson, the British Ambassador in Berlin, and by Herr von "ibbentrop, the German Foreign Minister. There were smiles and Heils on all sides for Britain's Ambassador for Peace, who inspected Storm Troopers before leaving the airport Then the Premier left with an escort of fast cars and drove along the motor road to Godesberg, where the second series of talks take place A suite had been reserved for the Prime Minister at the hotel Petersberg high among the hills of the hine --- on the opposite side of the river from the hotel where Hitler was waiting of fter a short rest Mr Chamberlain went to the Hotel reesen to resume discussions with the Fuehrer. The world waited, on a note of optimism; then came rumours of a breakdown; contradicion; then came the news that Mr Chamberlain was
