EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS.

The eighth National Euchariatic Congress, which claimed thousands of devout Roman Catholics anxious to answer the call of their faith, ended at New Orleans. Cardinal Mundeleim, Archbishop of Chichago, led an impressive procession through the streets on the last day of the Congress. The Cardinal spoke to Gaumont-Irish News on the solution to the present day difficult problems of the world, making a strong plea for peace. The Papal Legate left for a visit to Italy, and was welcomed by the American Ambassador in Rome, and by Cardinal Ascalesi of Naples. The American Cardinal received a great ovation and military honours by the Italian Army, and boarded the U.S.A. hatthuships battleships "OMAHA" to pay a sourtesy visit to her commander.
