A horse show is always an interesting event, and this yeer's show at the Grand Palais in Paris was no exception. One of the chief items on the programme was a feature displaying French artillery down the ages, an historic retrospect of France's mounted troops since the year 1792. A pageant of nearly 150 years of noble history slowly unfurled itself, a paralle of military uniforms and magnificent trappings worthy of the majestyl of France.
