Each county is identified by special touch symbols which also tell ken to which nation each colony belongs. Though they are bereft of the priceless gift of sight, nevertheless these brave people cam learn all thinken that can be learned about the different countries of the world. The models of buildings give them a knowledge of architectural form. They particularly study their own cities. Here's a model of Brisbane's impressive city hall. To they the sensitive touch of the blind, details of roads, rivers, bridges and buildings are revealed. These men and women are keen or kwener than those gifted with sight. They help one another with a brave resolve of the blind overcoming their handleap by the aid of human ingenuity and human kindlineas.
