M. Lebrun stopped at Saverne, Reichshoffen and Strasbourg in the course of his visit to the battle area of France. The French President made a comprehensive tour of the district, and it was in Saverne that he inspected tanks and talked with members of the Corps who had seen active service. In Reichshoffen he was greeted by schoolchildren under the care of nuns.

Nearby, in the Moselle ~~district~~ sector, there have been floods, although in the better weather following the day when these pictures were taken, they subsided. But the peril carries on --- and the important strategic points of his line of defence are on high ground, above the level of the water.
