And upon the recommendation of the Committee the Council took action without parallel in the League's history. It expelled the Soviet Republic from its membership The strong action of the League followed the uncivilised aerial bombardment of Helsinki --- of which we have already shown you the most vivid pictures Helsinki to-day is a city of mourning for many families.
