Mr Churchill was also present in the garden of General Gort's chateau when the Legion of Honour was conferred upon the B.E.F. Game Commander-in-Chief and on Sir Wdmund Ironside. The desorations were conferred upon the British Army leaders by General Gamelin, Commander-in-Chiefof the Allied Armies. The Grand Cross of the Legion of Honour is the highest honour France can beston.

Guards of honour were formed by the 8th Regiment of Zouaves and the Welsh Guards, and after the impressive ceremony the Generals took the salute at the march past
