R.A.F. FUNERAL IN HOLLAND.

In Holland, the pilot of a Royal Air Force bomber was buried with full military honours. Returning from a reconnaissance flight over Germany the British machine got off its course, and flew over Holland. Dutch fighters went up and opened fire, and the British bomber was shot down in flames. Holland's regret at the consequences of this technical breach of neutrality is obvious in these pictures of a tribute to one of the victims of the Nazi war.

NAZI SHIP IN LONDON.

Another prize for Britain --- taken from Germany by the Royal Navy. The 7,000-ton German cargo ship Uhenfels was captured in the South Atlantic with a cargo of produce from the West Indies. The Uhenfels was taken last November --- she now has the distinction of being the first Nazi ship to visit London since the war began.

QUEEN AT ALDERSHOT.
