Stowed out planes slightly -

PLANE PARACHUTE.

Here's something new in the air--- a parachute ~~that~~  
*with an unusual job,*  
~~floats and a plane to earth.~~ And it's a big one. It has to be,  
because it's a parachute for a plane.

Stowed in the fuselage- it's an unusual safety  
device. And inventor Jimmie Goodwin gives a demonstration---  
He takes off to show how a sky craft if disabled, can descend by  
parachute. When he releases the chute, this is what happens---

It billows out behind the moving plane and is over  
50 ft in diameter. The point of support, being at the middle ~~bits~~  
*that*  
between the wings, ensures/the plane is always level.

This is not one man baling out, it's a whole plane  
doing it. He lands--- but with a bit of a bump. He unhooks  
the parachute so that blown by the wind, it won't drag the plane  
along.
