world. Actual details of its performance are naturally secret;

but the top speed of the Airacobra is 400 miles an hour: it

is fitted with a cannon firing through the propeller hub, and

and in the air in formation these representatives of American

factories look a deadly lot.

Our cameraman flies alongside in a special plane; noting the magnificent formation kept by the Royal Air Force pilots at the controls. In appearance they are not unlike the Spitfire --- and if their record in action proves to be as good, the Luftwaffe has a lot more trouble ahead.

Speed, manoeuvrability and fire power are proved O.K.
