VISIT TO ANCIENT BUDDHIST TEMPLE.

On the beautiful island of Ceylon, there are several ancient Buddhist temples.

And visitors to one of these imposing shrines were honoured with a stately procession of elephants.

This pictures que cavalcade was headed by traditional musicians and dancers to the Temple.

It is interesting to watch how each elephant bows to the dais before proceeding on its way.

At the archway before the xemmer temple, the visitors were received by the Chief Insumbent who conducted them to the foot of the steps. A large number of monks assembled on the temple steps charting religious passages, - and them one of the monks read an address of welcome.

One of the most interesting features of Ceylon is the ancient Rock Fortress. In the year 470 A.D. a local gentleman murdered his father; in order to escape punishment, he and his followers built this fortress home on a 400 ft rock.

They lived there gor many years in safety - From this noble landmark, it is possible to enjoy magnificent views of typical Ceylon country.
