Germany and Austria- Floods along the Danube- 13/7/

Upper Bavaria --- This is the tragic aftermath of 60 hours of incessant rain -- the flooded countryside bound Rosenheim -- about 30 miles SE of Munich.

Flying in a gelicopter over the inundated valleys, we see how the Danube, Inn, and ten smaller rivers swept over their banks, completely isolating farms and homesteads over a wide area.
