

Sussex: Permanent waves were fashioned on the South Coast - when top hairdressets from eight European countries competed, at Brighton, in the Fifth World Cup Championships.

Held for the first time in Britain - there were separate contests for glamorous evening styles - high fantasy and practical day-time dressings.

Each team consisted of five hairdressers - each with their own models.

The four previous contests were won by France and here are some of the finished effects that called for hair-line decisions from the international panel of judges.

Grand Prix
