Scotland -- Bulldozers at work clearing mud and rubble from the squelching streets bear grim testimony to the havos of the 72 hour reinstorm, which struck North of the Border- and parts of Northern England.

At Newmilns, Ayrahare, tell-tale marks on houses, which bore the first want water shocks of the avalanche of and, record the height reached by the swirling cloops. one car was actually harled into a garden- IOO yards away.

And Termsc- 2 feet thick- was ripped open by the uprush of an underground stream, after Scotland's worst reinstorm in living memory.

Now an aerial view of the island of Haiti in the Caribbean. Here the death roll ram into three figures in the wake of "Hurricane Hasel", the giad described tropical storm that went on to lash the Eastern Seaboard of North America.

The hurricane (the eighth and worst of the season) then swept markements anorth-westwards through Toronto- Canada's second largest city- which bore the full bount of the lashing wind and rain.

Rivers broke their banks over a wide area, while many trapped householders with rescues.

the rich fruits of the land (which had just been harvested) - were cause the rampaging waters, before they could reach market.

"Hurricane Hazel" finally blew itself out in Hudson Bay, and leaving behind over 3000 miles of death and destruction- a Costly and wisitor.
