

Central America:

fartaxBira: Following the outbreak of border fighting in Costa Rica, a

fourteen-men Commission (representing the Organisation of American States)

arrives in San Jose, the Capital, to investigate charges that the revolt

was organised in neighbouring Nicaragua.

Later, when the Commission reported that Costa Rica could not repel Rebel air attacks, the United States sent four Mustang fighters at the nominal cost of one dollar.

Connecticut: A year after she was launched, the "Mautilus" - the world's first atomic-powered submarine heads down-river to Long Island Sound to idergo her first sea trials.

A three-thousand ton vessel, the submarine cost well over ten million pounds and can travel round the world without refuelling. And now comes news that the first "test dive" has been successful.
