AMTIGUA welcomes the Island's first Hoyal Visitor for thirty-five years.

And it was typical of Princess (with her long interest in Youth movements) that her first visit was to a Rally of six-thousand School-children on the cricket ground.

During the afternoon, six hundred guests attended a Garden Party in the grounds of Government House - and many were presented - the reward for long years of loyal service to the Island community.

A more formal occasion was the State Dinner Party - and The Her Royal

Highness (wearing a floral evening gown) was later entertained in the West Indian manner that won her heart in Trinidad SOUND.

First discovered by Christopher Columbus, Antigua has long associations with the moyal Navy. For 160 years, anglish Harbour was the main Naval base in the Eastern Caribbean, and was once commanded and the Mercon.
