

Surrey: The first public demonstration of Britain's new armoured giant - the mighty "Conqueror" - the sixty-five ton tank that packs a punch to match its size.

The new heavyweight showed its paces at the Fighting Vehicle Research Establishment at Chobham - and here, for comparison, the 49-ton Centurion joins the picture.

Many of the Conqueror's details are still undisclosed - including the size of that gun - but it certainly makes a big secret!

Designed to add increased striking power to the Centurion force, the Conqueror carries a crew of four, and will shortly undergo ~~extensive~~ troop trials, with the British Army, in Germany.
