In the various departments, the assistants explained the complicated processes by which finished material is tested for strength....and the endless research that is being carried out to improve the wearing qualities of man-made fabrics.

In another section, the Duke saw a machine that can make 250 different tests of a sample of yarn. Then later caused great amusement when he said:
"I hope this place does all it is supposed to do."

After lunching with Lord and Lady Derby, Prince Philip drove to Liverpool University - to open a new block (dedicated to inorganic and physical chemistry) by unveiling a commemorative tablet...
