## Telephone cable

North America. Once a far-off dream, it has been made possible by the laying of the first trans-Atlantic under-water cable - at a cost of fifteen million pounds.

During the past two years, H.M. Telegraph Ship "Monarch" has laid an atlantic cable in each direction. Now the service, (recently opened) brings greatly improved reception. There are thirty-five different lines and a call costs 23 for the first three minutes.
