Egypt: Into Abu Sueir airfield, (a former R.A.F. base) come the first detachments of the United Nations Police Force. The first arrivals were some ninety men from Denmark and Norway - the vanguard of a force that, it is thought, will number around six thousand men from over twenty countries.

Latest reports say that the men will undertake patrol duties in border areas. Only a token force (mostly salvage crews), will remain in the Canal Zone - to clear the 49 wrecks in the waterway.

Already, the effect of the hold-up of international shipping has been felt in Western Europe, chiefly through the drastic reduction in oil supplies.

Following <sup>this</sup> a sweep by British and French Naval vessels, the 25-mile northern stretch of the Canal, held by the Allied Forces, has been declared free of mines.
