Paris - ~~With the fall of the Government,~~ the French Premier, ~~Mr~~ Mollet, went to the Elysee Palace, to tender his resignation to President Coty. This, the longest-lived Ministry since the war, had been defeated by two hundred and fifty votes to two hundred and thirteen - due to the Premier's bill for increased taxation.

Since the liberation, there have been twenty-two Governments in France.
