At 1400 feet below ground level-- Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother had an unusual experience when she visited workers in the Roan Antelope copper mine in Northern Rhodesia.

This was one of the last engagements of Her Majesty's fifteen-day tour of the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland.

Wearing a white dust coat over her grey dress, and with plastic helmet and cap-lamp, the Queen Mother watched, with the greatest interest, the workings of the mine which employs over 10,000 workers- 8000 of them Africans. BEFORE LEAVING THERE WERE
