THE RUSIAN OPENSIVE.

The sweeping success of the Russian summer offensive is now so firmly established, that in the opinion of many observers, German withdrawal, particularly in the K Ukraine, South to the Sea of Amof, has now become the greatest retreat in Military history. Through sweepland swellen by heavy rains the Russians press on, pleughing stubbernly forward through the Denets Basin in their drive toward the Dneiper River. Kursk, Byelgored and Tagamere are now far behind as the Red Army wins back village after village.

Masi night raiders run into heavy anti-airctaft fire as they seek to prise the Russians loose from their positions.

Wrecked equipment marks the read of the German route at Tagamreg and Mariupol.

Russian successes around Smolensk rebbed the Nazis of hundreds of locamotives. This is the nearest Russian-held point so far to Peland. Ever westward roll the Soviet Armies.

The deepest penetrations yet made into the 1941 German line have been the fruits of Marshal Stalin's brilliant offensive.

On toward the Basiper, while the threat to German-held Kiev grows almost hourly. Hasi attempts to consolidate are smashed, as the forced German exodus from Russia is hastened before the approaching winter.
