"Look you, here's another". Lowrie kicks the third Welsh goal and puts the team only one behind England. But the improvement didn't last long. Hagan chalked up another for England, and then in five nerve-shattering minutes the sixth, seventh and eighth English goals came flying off the boot from Compton, Hagan and Welsh.

Score 7-3 England's favour. Rapidly a new record is being set. The highest scoring win ever recorded in an International at Wembley.

Penalty kick, and Welsh scores from the spot. The memory of that game is left to "Time, the great Healer".
