RAIDS IN THE RAIN.

Wearing his shirt outside his pants, Pathe Gazette Cameraman, Oscar Bovill (on the right) follows the tropical custom. It's the Monsoon Season in Burma, a period of steady heat and blinding rain storms. Operating with an R.A.F. Squadron, Bovill sets out to show how Klenheim Bomber crews carry on under these abnormal conditions, when the heavy-laden storm-clouds "weep their burden to the ground".

Reports of Jap troop concentrations send this formation on their mission. Breaks in the cloud were sufficient to enable the bomb aimers to identify their target.

Looking down on the Jungle Town of MINBYA, sweltering in liquid heat, the place shimmers like molten metal under the combined effect of light from a powerful sun and shadow cast by the vaporous clouds.
