of the Course, and takes the lead with Growing Confidence and
Tehran close by.

third. So Garden Path was the perfect lady, and the first filly
to win the Two Thousand Guineas in the last forty-two years.....
Lord Derby decided to run Garden Path in preference to any of his
colts. How right he was!
