- 9, M.S. DUKW rolls up on beach and off steps General Montgomery, he surveys the beachhead. 31
- 10, Ground to air of glider force being towed over France. 25
- 11, M.S. Glider laying in fields and places they have crash landed. 13
- 12, V.S. Troops advance through countryside on the 7th June, then through towns. The Americans and British troops encounter street fighting. 86
- 13, V.S. Sherman tanks move slowly through villages with few inhabitants cheering. The tanks are en route to Caen. 48
- 14, V.S. German prisoners being rounded up. 40
- 15, V.S. A Rhino raft taking the prisoners out towards the landing craft onto which they transfer. A high ranking officer is amongst this party. 67
- 16, V.S. The German prisoners arriving by landing craft on British soil. 37
