NEWS AND VIEWS FROM ITALY

- 1, V.S. Of the badly bombed town of Ancona. Railway station wrecked and bombed out train. 34
- 2, V.S. Troopship arriving in Naples bringing more forces. These are Brazilian soldiers who will serve with the American Army, they wear Brazil shoulder flashes. The troops come down gangplank. (Gen. Devers present). 25
- 3, L.S. Scenes in Rome in June of German infantry and mechanised units evacuating the City. Shots are taken by secret cameraman. 40
- 4, V.S. Italian widows lay flowers at rough graves, victims of Nazi massacre. 38
- 5, G.V. St Peter's Square and Vatican. 12
- 6, M.S. Allied troops entering and leaving the Vatican. 20
- 7, V.S. Congregation of Allied Servicemen inside to hear the Pope. He speaks S.O.F. in English, he praises the liberators and blesses them all. He is then carried shoulder high along aisles past the troops. 130
