## WESTERN FRONT WAR REPORT.

Anchem as allied airmen see it, battered and beaten.....The battle for Anchem has been a test case which the rest of Germany watched anxiously. The German people must relise by new that the continuation of the war inside the Retth can mean only terrible leases and the amashing of their towns and cities.

German grip on South Western Helland is Loosened another stage as British tree; advance into the Cathedral City of Mortegenbosch.

Captured Germans take one of their wounded for a ride.... They're all in the eart really and they knowith...... The rest of the uninjured prisoners, have to make do with Shanks' Pény.

North of Antwerp, British treeps and tanks drive on in yet another thrust. This move brings our forces one stage nearer to the Glearance of all approaches to Antwerp. The Scholdt estuary, key to the port, is the prime.

Canadian Army Film Unit cameramen turn in the first pictures of the amphibious invasion of Bevdland. Alligators plough their way across the Scholdt towards the long low line of the coast.

The shore is reached and the Alligators claw their way up the maddy slopes. Beach heads are soon established and men and their supplies swarm in to join with forces advancing along the mack of the peninsuler.

From Alligators, to another item in the Allies' Zoo'ef surprises for the Germans - the weasel....which is equally at home in mad, water, ditches and if necessary on ordinary solid earth or readways.

Then there is the IVT 4 - also amphibious... which hatches out recommaissence cars - a simple operation.

At Tilburg the fortune of the Masis is no better. Allied troops, crossing the the canal in assault beats, bustle the Germans out of the forpress town. A formida le series of obstructions were left by the Germans, Blown bridges caused our forces considerable trouble but could not provent their determined advance.

At a quarter-to-eleven, the streets begin to fill with the excited citizens of Tilburg who rush to receive their liberators.

The winning of removed freedom in enemy eccupied countries in Western Europe has proved hardest of attainment in Holland, but difficulties, however great, will prove no deterrent to ultimate success.
