MEN OF ARNHEM AT PALACE

More than 60 decorations were presented at an investiture when Arnhem glider men and Paratroops were inspected by the King. Major Cain, Royal Northumberland Fusiliers, wears the ribbon of the V.C. General Browning, first sponsor of Britain's Airborne Troops, and the Commander of the Division, General Urquhart, each received the Insignia of a Companion of the Order of the Bath. Except for a few passers-by, Londoners were unaware of the stirring spectacle of several hundred Heroes of Arnhem marching from the Palace. The unfortunate loss of opportunity to cheer these brave men may yet be made good.
