OSLO EXPLOSION

Devastation and death in Oalo Harbour. A huge mine and a fully leaded ammunition ship exploded killing a hundred and twenty people and injuring hundreds of others. Fifteen Nerwegian soldiers were killed and British and American servicemen were smong the injured.

The majority of the dead were German prisoners of war. Two thousand of them were waiting in the harbour to embark on repatriation skips. Others were loading German assumition on to barges for damping in deep water in Calo Fjord. The tunult and the shouting have died away but even wards diminishing seho has the power to kill and desirey.
