It was an absolute miracle the way in about four hours they get her going again and landing on her aircraft, and new that I have been on beard, and I come in her, now I know how it happened, because in the ship they've get the most wonderful teamork and most happiest, the biggest heart of a ship's company I have ever seen. One thing they've never forgetten, they've left behind out there very gallant shipmates which they lost in Kamikase attacks -left behind a posthumous V.C., and a let of very gallant aircrews of the Pacific, and although everybedy is so interested new and everybyed at coming back, believe men the comrades they've left behind will never, never be forgetten."
