Pinpoint in the Pacific Ocean is the World's newest island, bern of an underwater veleane. The little patch of grey reck is wrapped in great blasts of moke, with the surrounding ocean beiling, and throwing out columns of supplements steem. Checking on the crupting sideshow, cameranen record another stage in the re-amakaning of Japan's velounic chain which began in 1940 after a thirty-year sleep. The new island is now 80 feet high and is still growing. But scientists expect the exception to spend itself and the new island to slip back underneath the sea.
