- CU Rear view of the Bombardier of the plane seated in the all glass nose of the plane, as he releases the bomb.
- LS Another view of the explosion, showing the huge column of smoke rising into the sky.
- WS Aerial shot of the explosion, mushroom like column of smoke, rather like a man's head, rises high into the sky.
- MS Ground view of the column of smoke rising into the sky, seen from the deck of one of the operating ships, sailors crowd against the ship's rails to get a view of the smoke.

CU Research experts take samples of water from the sea, to test its radioactive content, as a small ship moves into the lagoon, to investigate the effects of the bomb.

CU US Navy Fire Fighting Ships play hoses onto burning ships in an effort to get fires under control.
- CU Sailors remove instruments etc from the deck of a target ship.
- CU Scientists examine samples taken from the ships, under Microscopes.

MS Damaged ships in the lagoon.
- CU Submarine, completely battered and destroyed, lying against the side of a heavily damaged Battleship.
