Scott comes up with some good clean punches to the face in the last round - but Taylor keeps his lead and gots the referee's decision.

In the top flyoweight fight wors Gerperal Murphy, (in white vest) and Gunner Renner. Murphy was way on top. Here Renner goes down for a count of 6.

He's up again showing plenty of courage, but Signals Corporal Hurphy hits out like a real champ. He misses with a couple of wild swings. But there is no mistake about the final knock-out blowmy It's curtains for young Renner.
