L.S. General views of the massive crown.

The massive crown is a characteristic feature of the
 species, and is seen in all specimens examined.
 It is composed of a number of small, rounded
 nodules, which are arranged in a regular, hexagonal
 pattern. The nodules are separated by distinct
 lines, and the overall appearance is that of a
 crystalline structure. The crown is usually
 found on the upper surface of the leaf, and
 is often associated with the presence of
 a certain amount of moisture. It is
 particularly prominent in the younger
 stages of the plant, and becomes
 less distinct as the plant matures.
