LANCASITER MILIONIES D.P.S.

This is Littleberough, in Lemenshire, three miles from Rochdele. For generations, the people who live here, have worked in the town's cotton mills. Today, new faces come to Littleberough. They are displaced persons. From the British Zone in Germany, the homeless of Burepe have come to Britain to be employed in undernamed essential industries. Here, in the heart of the county funcd for its textiles, a party of 40 girls gets a real Lemenshire valence.

A few years age some of these D.Ps were students, storehoopers, teilors, clerks. New they are the first this batch of foreign workers to come to Britain. The majority of Littleborough's new mill girls come from the former Baltie States and from the Ukraine. For political reasons they say it is impossible for them to return to their own countries. This group is a part of the 10,000 who have already arrived here. And this is Littleborough making them feel at home.

Once they were displaced persons - now Lencashire begins to teach them a new lenguage.
