At Kingston-upon-Hull the Schools Athletic Association parade before the Lord Lieutenant of the East Riding, Lord Middleton. At Malaby Road Cricket Ground these 17th Inter-County Championships drew 1000 competitors from 25 counties. As hosts, the Yorkshire team led the parade.

Hull's Lord Mayor - Alderman Robinson - was among the 10,000 spectators. With the ground still trim from the Yorkshire-Kent cricket match, conditions were almost ideal for new records.

31 girls competed for the long jump title, while on the other side of the ground the under 16's fought it out over 100 yards.

Winner of the long jump was Buckingham's Lora Lee with a record jump of 18ft. For Hull it was a day of records.

Dorchester celebrates Tolpuddle Martyrs Day. One hundred and thirteen years ago, six farm workers were sentenced to be transported for seven years. They had formed a trade union which was then illegal. Chancellor Hugh Dalton and Carnival Queen Phyllis Russell mark the send off to this first post-war revival of Tolpuddle Week.

A mile long procession through the town included a tableau that showed the six men of Tolpuddle being brought in chains to stand trial at Dorset Assizes.
