WOLF LIGHTHOUSE

Britain's lonliest Lighthouse Wolf Rock has been isolated for 23 days. At Penzance, nearest port of call, the men of Trinity House plan relief for the marooned keepers. The emergency rations packed in water tight cannisters are loaded up, time is short as the men of Wolf Rock eat up their last supplies of beef and biscuits. At the quayside Trinity House relief ship Triton prepares to challenge mountainous seas, as she steams out the gale blows up with a renewed force. The safe harbour of Penzance fades into the distance. Wolf Rock's relief is at hand. Pitching and tossing the Triton battles on, inside the lighthouse are three men one of them is Britain's youngest seamen. Held captive by the worst Atlantic gale for 30 years they have been imprisioned here since before Xmas. 3 men provide another example of the endurance of Britains lighthouse keepers.
