WAR IN PALESTINE FROM THE ARAB SIDE:

Story No. 1.

✓ King of Transjordan Abdullah in Jerusalem the day of the Truce. He enters into the Old City from St. Stephens Gate occupied by the Arab Legion to the sound of the bagpipes. Later on he goes to the Mosque of Omar to pray to Allah. (The filming of the interior of the Mosque in general and especially in these circumstances is prohibited. This film was taken in secret).

Story 2.

✓ Jerusalem during the Truce. Business in the Old City commenced immediately. The last fights and the last wounded. The flag of the Red Cross flies over the City. The Arab guns are silent.

Story 3.

Exchange of prisoners. The Arabs pass the front line at New Gate under the protection of the Red Cross of Geneva, and Arab women from the French Hospital occupied by the Haganah pass through 'no man's land'. General view of the French Hospital (Jewish lines). Over the big walls (Arab lines).

Although in the North of Palestine at Tourkharm the Jewish women were returned to Haganah by the Arab Legion, in fact Abdullah did not consider the women as combatants. The delegate of the Red Cross Dr. Courvoisier waving his flag.

Young woman of the Haganah finds her fiance.
