Neet Ensch Lewis - 48-years-old - A Welsh miner who works at two mines every day. For 10 hours a day, he is the manager at Rock Fawr Galliery, Tandu. On the other side of Aberhanfig is Ensch Lewis² other mine. In his little ear, he drives across the mountains while his mates go home to tea. Mr. Lewis cats his while driving to the uninhabited valley where he operates his own one-man celliery. There for 14 years he has spent his spare time digging. Now he has been granted a license by the Ocal Board to mine the best house ceal in Britain. To reach this rich ceal sean, Mr. Lewis had to blast his way single handed through 250 yards of solid rock. Today, his pit tunnel is seven foot high, perfectly timbered-and-walled, Everything here he has done himself, with no outside help at all.

His life savings have been spent in perfecting his exacting task, but already Mr. Lowis has mined 30 tens of coal - the first results of his 14 year battle. Today, miner Ensch Lowis becomes the first man in Britain to operate his own pit.
