BLASE DESTROYS U.S. ARMY BASE

Exploding oil drums hurl columns of liquid fire eight hundred feet into the sky, as a midnight blase sweeps through a warehouse at the Oakland, California, Army base.

The giant warehouse was packed with Army equipment intended for Japan. Six minutes after the first spark had ignited an oil drum, the entire length of the half-nile pier was engulfed in flames. Pirenen, unable to extinguish the blasing informe, concentrate on saving mearby property.

Half a million pounds worth of supplies go up in spectacular flames in America's biggest fire of the year.
