

GLASGOW PLANS FOR TOMORROW

With 800 years of history behind it, Glasgow Today, takes a look into Tomorrow, as the Corporation puts on an exhibition in Kelvin Hall, foreshadowing the proposed new "Inner Core" of the City. A scale model, one-hundredth full-size, shows the bold outline of the Glasgow-to-be in sharp contrast to the City-that-was.

The New Glasgow is planned in zones, each serving commercial, civic and residential needs. New stations are part of a completely-reorganised transport system.

A great City sees its new contours take-shape. Scots will find it hard to recognise the old town. But with even an entertainment zone allowed for, Glasgie still belongs to them - especially on Saturday nights.
