COSSACES LEAD ANTI-SOVIET PLOTS

10,000 people jam Munich's Koenigsplatz to stege the biggest yet demonstration against Soviet Russia's policy. In this square once the scene of many a Masi meeting - this lost flotsem of Europe (none of whem are able to return to their homes in Russia) protest against the Soviet's ruthless persecution of the Churches. Speaker after speaker whips up the crowd's angry mod. In a mile-lang procession, demonstrators head for the Soviet military headquarters. Before they reach the building, they elash with a squad of German communists. There follows the biggest free fight seen since Masi days. American military police - arms at the ready - move in to break it up.

Using tear gas, the troops succeed in dispersing the crowd. The demonstrators' flags come in handy, as the Cossack leaders leave the street battleground for the American police to clear up.

Not result of half-an-hours hand-to-hand fighting - casualties mil - change in Seviet policy - also mil.
