ATLANTIC PACT NATIONS MEET IN WASHINGTON

In Washington, the Foreign Ministers of the twelve Atlantic Pact Nations meet in the first session of the North Atlantic Council. The Council votes to establish defence and military committees and - at the instigation of Mr. Bevin - a system of regional defence groups will be set up. While the free-thinking nations get together to plan a common future, the world's "odd man out" - Soviet Russia's Andrei Vishinsky, arrives in New York for the United Nations Assembly, and surprises everybody by speaking in English for the first time.
